

Class C Surface Water Operator

Seeking full time Surface Water Treatment Plant C Operator. Minimum experience of 3 years, High School Diploma or Equivalent, \$20.00-\$24.00/Hr, Benefits package included.

Requirements:

- High School Diploma or GED (Bachelors in a technical field preferred)
- Minimum 3 years closely related experience
- Minimum Texas Class "C" Surface Water Operator License (or equivalent from another state)
- Must currently live or be willing to relocate to within 30 minutes drive from the intersection of Harlan Rd and State Highway 6 south of College Station, TX

Duties include, but not limited to:

- Assist and participate in the operations of the Districts' water treatment facility, pump stations and storage tanks;
- Assist in the control and operation of treatment plant chemicals, machines, and equipment to purify and clarify water for human consumption and industrial use.
- Assist in the collection of water samples from the plant and distribution system; performs chemical, physical, and bacteriological tests to ensure water quality; submits samples for testing as required by state agencies. Helps determine dosages for chemicals such as chlorine, ammonia, aluminum sulfate, caustic and copper sulfate for treatment of water.
- Assist and participate in the performance of routine chemical tests and analyses for chlorine, PH, turbidity, alkalinity, hardness and conductivity levels of drinking water.
- Manages the solids removal from treatment units and backwash of filters.

- Maintains the efficiency of plant and laboratory operations, including maintenance of equipment, pumps, filters and machinery, testing, quality control and record keeping procedures.
- Calibrates laboratory equipment and determines appropriate chemical feed rates for optimal water treatment.
- Monitors plant records, including operations logs, daily diaries, and chemical inventories;
- Assists in preparation of reports as required by regulatory agencies.
- Monitors performance of process machinery and equipment, prepares maintenance schedule, leads in equipment maintenance and repair work.
- Assist supervisor in overseeing the safety of personnel by training employees in proper safety procedures and monitoring work in progress.
- Insures orders of chemicals, supplies and materials as needed; requisitions purchase orders.
- Assists regulatory agencies with annual inspections of facilities.
- May be on call after hours to respond to emergency situations. Performs other duties as assigned.
